His Masters Voice – The background story of the Confidence Signature

The Confidence Signature project was inspired by Dynaudio co-founder and CEO Wilfried Ehrenholz.

Alongside some legendary Dynaudio classics, the Confidence remains his favourite Dynaudio loudspeaker series. Listening to his own personal Confidence C1 and C2 models, he has always had the ambition of one day making the best even better.

“Since their introduction, the Confidence models set remarkable standards with their refined, detailed sound and excellent sound staging. The Confidence mated our finest Esotar² tweeter and high performance woofers with the advanced DDC technology. But some years later, and with the knowledge gained from extraordinary loudspeakers like the Sapphire and the Consequence Ultimate Edition, we wanted to make the Confidence even better. The ultimate refinement in sound” says Wilfried Ehrenholz, Dynaudio co-founder and CEO.

Efforts to improve these models were quite difficult, as every part of the Confidence, from the shape of its sound-optimized baffle to the premium drive units and the innovative DDC technology, already makes each model a finely balanced, inherently consistent loudspeaker. A new level of fine-tuning and the experience gained from creating the exceptional Dynaudio Sapphire and Consequence Ultimate edition now yield into this most refined Signature edition. One of the technologies directly transferred from the Consequence is the re-designed crossover using rare ceramic film resistors in the high-frequency part.

“The new ceramic film resistors are extremely linear over their frequency spectrum, with ultra-low tolerance and totally free of inductivity and capacity. This has audible advantages in keeping the delicate high frequencies as pure and distortion-free as possible” says Mark Thorup, Dynaudio Concept Manager.

Further upgrades include a higher-grade oxygen-free copper cable for the internal wiring, plus the renowned Esotar² tweeter now further refined with Precision Coating.

“Dynaudio has always used a special coating that is applied as a liquid and then slowly dries. A time-consuming, demanding process, but in terms of sound quality it is the best method. With ‘Precision Coating’ the liquid composition and the coating process have been further optimized, resulting in higher refinement and better detail resolution” adds Roland Hoffmann, Dynaudio Product Manager.

Two new finishes, dark-brown Mocca and dark-red Bordeaux, are exclusively available to the Confidence Signature range. These finishes were first introduced in the limited-edition Sapphire model, celebrating Dynaudio’s 30th anniversary. When the first experimental Confidence models were finished by the carpenters at Dynaudio in Denmark, Wilfried Ehrenholz was sure that this will be the perfect finishing touch on the Signature project:

“Improvements in sound quality always come first at Dynaudio. But the unparalleled sheen of the piano-lacquered Mocca or Bordeaux real wood veneer, matched with the silk-black front baffle gives the Confidence also a new, breath-taking appearance” explains Wilfried Ehrenholz.

In addition to the new finishes the Confidence Signature models proudly feature an aluminium backplate plate adorned with the signature of Wilfried Ehrenholz and feature a 10-year warranty.

With all these refinements, the new Confidence Signature edition is the best sounding and most refined Confidence series ever.
